



- Tell the story of Guy Fawkes
- Use 2D/3D shapes to make rockets.
- Use black paper and have some cut out rockets for the children to count out into the sky (black paper).
- Build a Guy Fawkes.
- Have a mini bonfire in a fire pit.
- Use large construction and children to build a bonfire to use for role play.
- Toast marshmallows on the fire.
- Fire lighting
- Cooking opportunities – Jacket potatoes, toffee apples, bonfire toffee.
- Discuss fire safety.
- Discuss how to keep pets safe on bonfire night.
- List the important things we should do on Bonfire Night.
- Sprinkle different coloured glitter onto a tuff tray and add large numbers and paint brushes for the children to practise number formation. Can be used with letters or CVC words etc...
- Paint a bonfire using the correct colours and collect sticks to glue onto the bottom.
- Use different tools such as washing up brushes, sponges to paint fireworks.
- Dance like a firework using firework noises.
- Make breadstick sparklers using breadsticks, chocolate and sprinkles.
- Have cards with different lines on them straight, curled, spiral and zig-zag to represent fireworks. Children can trace over them or attempt to recreate the firework lines on paper, in sand or glitter.
